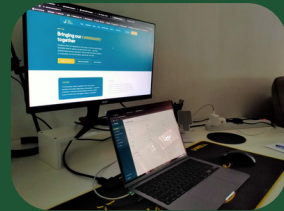

For the first time, I was completely alone. No family. No familiar community. And suddenly, a lifestyle worlds apart from mine was everywhere — normalised, and honestly, it looked like everyone was having the time of their lives.

That's the part nobody warns you about. It's not the obvious haram that gets you. It's the slow, quiet normalisation of it. The way "just this once" starts to sound reasonable when everyone around you is saying it with a smile. I made a decision to be intentional — about where I spent my time, who I spent it with, and what I said yes and no to. Was it lonely sometimes? Yes. Did people think I was boring? Probably. But every single thing I gave up for the sake of Allah, He replaced with something better. الحمد لله. The Prophet ﷺ said: "If you leave something for the sake of Allah, Allah will replace it with something better."
